#### UNIVERSITY OF VALÈNCIA

The University of València (Valencian: Universitat de València) is a university located in the Spanish city of València. It is one of the oldest surviving universities in Spain, and the oldest in the Valencian Community, and is regarded as one of Spain's leading academic institutions. The University was founded in 1499, and currently has around 55,000 students. Most of the courses are given through the medium of Spanish, but the university has promised to increase the number of courses available in Valencian, their own official language along with Spanish. Moreover, in some degrees part of the teaching is in English.

It is located in the Mediterranean Spanish baseline, in the city of València which is the capital and most populous city of the autonomous community of València and the third largest city in Spain, with a population of 829,705 in 2014. One of its campuses is located in the metropolitan area of Valencia, in the municipalities of Burjassot and Paterna. The University of Valencia has 18 Schools and Faculties located in its three main campuses. Each one allocates different academic departments and offers undergraduate, official masters and PhD programs.

The Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry is responsible for the administrative management and the organisation of University Courses leading to the achievement of the Medicine and Surgery Graduate Degree and the Odontology Graduate Degree.

Historically, the Faculty can be considered as one of the most prominent Spanish Medical Schools for five centuries. In this time, it has been subjected to diverse social, economic, political and cultural factors. For this reason, the quality of teaching, the peak of its scientific production and its capacity for adaptation to the most renewing medical trends has changed over the years. Consequently, the creation of the Licenciatura in Odontology (10/86 Law) the Faculty of Medicine changes its name to Medicine and Dentistry to handle the teaching of both Licenciaturas from the 1987/88 Course. It is integrated in the UV's structure, a Public Law institution, with its own legal status and heritage, with its rights acknowledged by the Constitution and the rest of laws in force.
