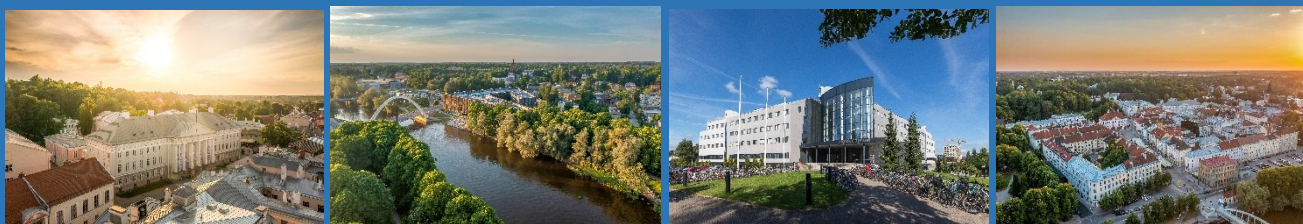

UNIVERSITY OF TARTU

The University of Tartu is Estonia's largest and oldest university, founded in 1632. We are Estonia's national university and the centre of the country's academic spirit. We are a strong research university, promoting education and research worldwide. More than 17,000 people work and study at the university.

The Faculty of Medicine has been the springboard for Estonian doctors and medical researchers since the founding of the alma mater - 1632. Arriving from Tallinn to Tartu

Express buses pick up passengers from Tallinn Airport on their way to Tartu. The airport bus station has a self-service ticket dispenser. The machine accepts card payments, but it is advisable to buy your ticket in advance as Tallinn-Tartu buses are often full. You can buy your ticket [here](#).

Transportation in Tartu

Moving around on foot

There is a saying that it's as if there is more time in Tartu – this is because the distances here are short and the connecting roads and pavements are in good condition. It's a 5-minute walk along the shore path of Emajõgi River from the bus station to the Town Hall Square in Old Town. From the city centre Biomedicum is a 35-minute walk away.

Moving around with bikes

The best way to move around the city is to rent a smart bike. You can choose between a regular bike or an electric one. The city is full of bike docs to take and park the vehicle easily. For prices and instructions see the website ratas.tartu.ee.

Moving around with electric scooters

You can also rent an electric scooter for a very low price to get to your destination quickly. You just need your phone to unlock the scooter and you are ready to go! Read all about this service on the [Bolt website](#).

Moving around by buses

You can very easily use public transport to get to your destinations. If you have the tapping option on your card or phone, you can buy a ticket with just one swipe. All of the information about public buses in Tartu can be found on the website tartu.ee.

Moving around by taxi
